Dieppe: Commercial sector begins year on high note

DIEPPE, N.B. — The City of Dieppe's building inspection division issued 39 permits in March totalling \$9,181,702.

The commercial sector dominated activity with 11 permits issued at a value of \$4,642,179, followed by the residential sector with 28 permits valued at \$4,539,523.

To date this year, 68 permits have been issued representing a total value of \$10,659,077, compared to \$4.3 million in March of 2010.

"At this same time last year, the city's commercial sector permits totalled \$498,161 compared to \$5,738,870 this year," said Mayor Jean LeBlanc. "This is a significant increase and indicates that the commercial sector is progressing well. Construction will be very strong in 2011."

March highlight:

-A permit valued at \$3,860,740 for expansion to the Pharmasave building.
